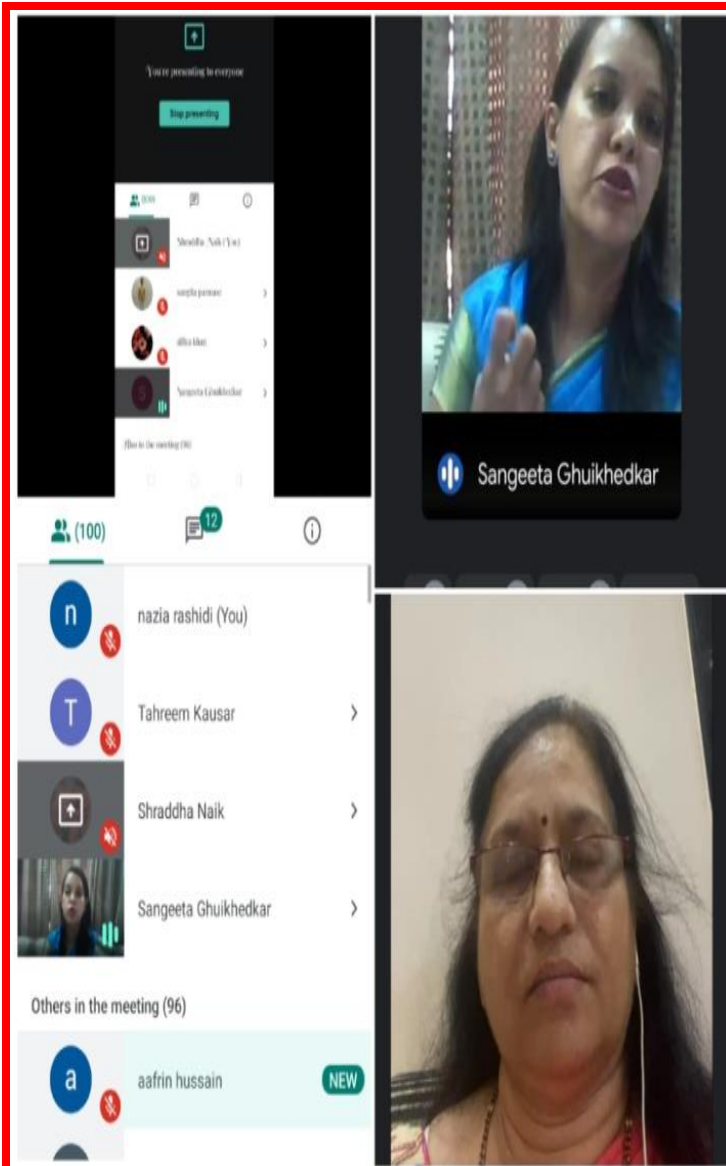

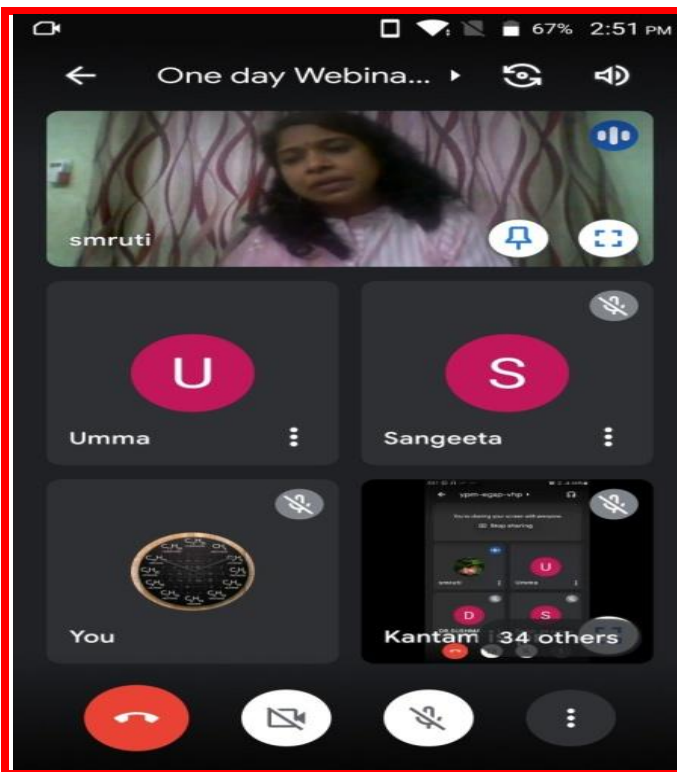

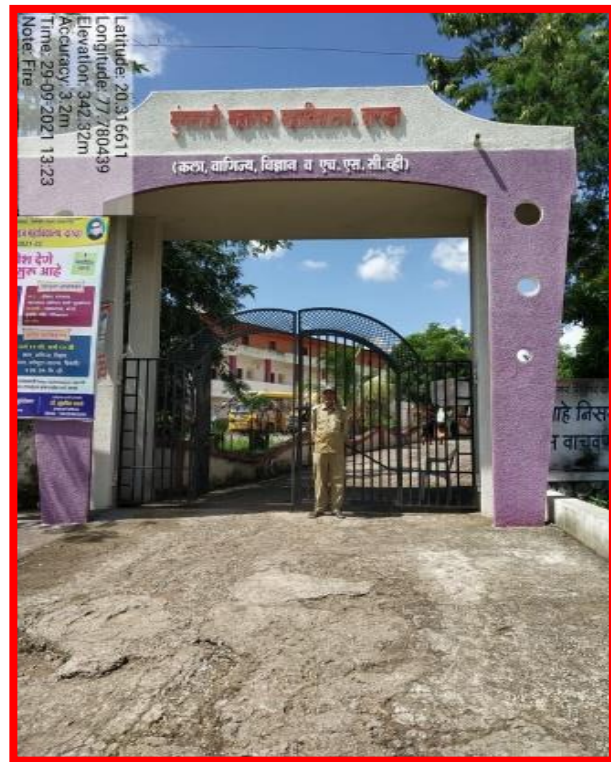
Specific initiatives with respect to key areas are as follows

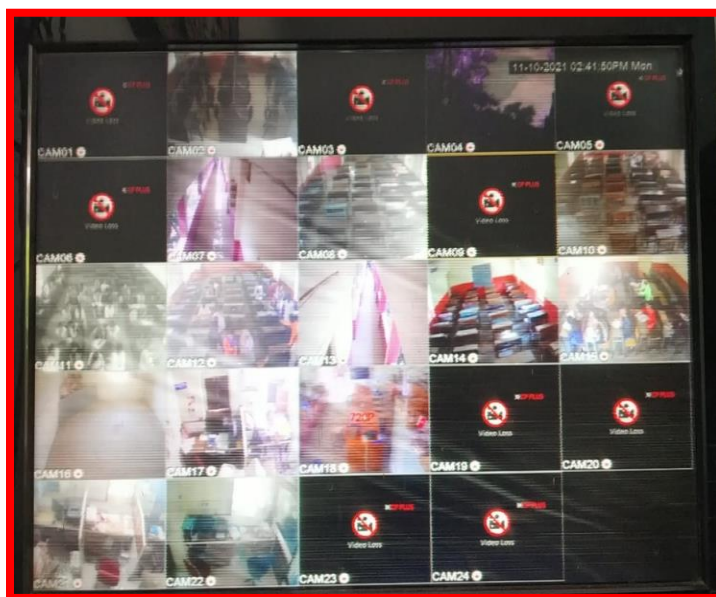

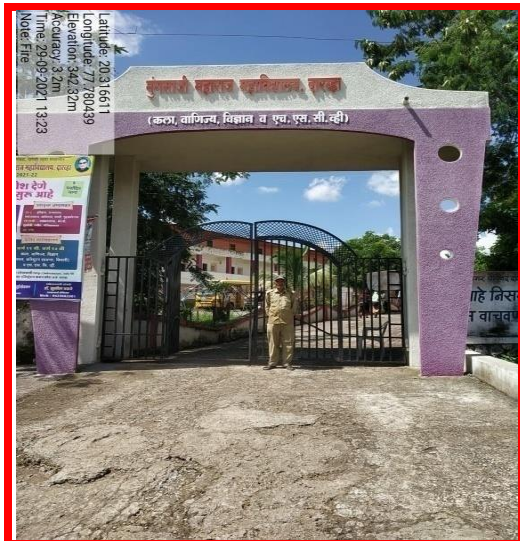

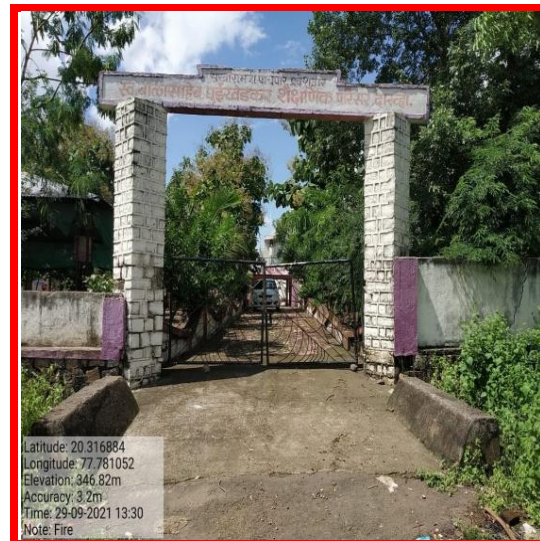

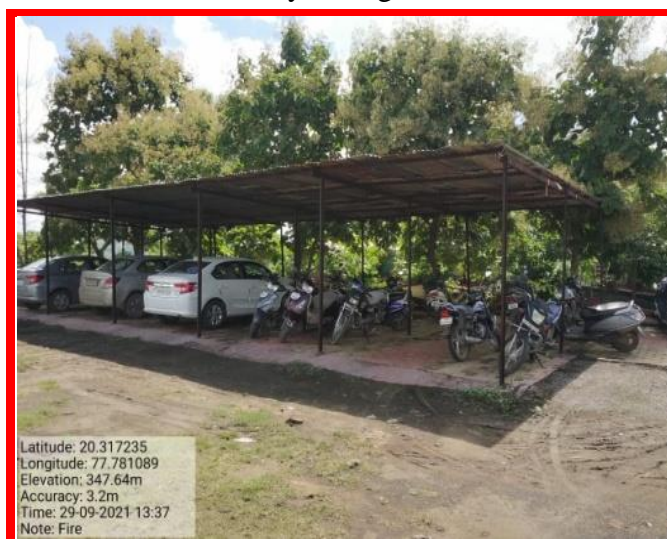

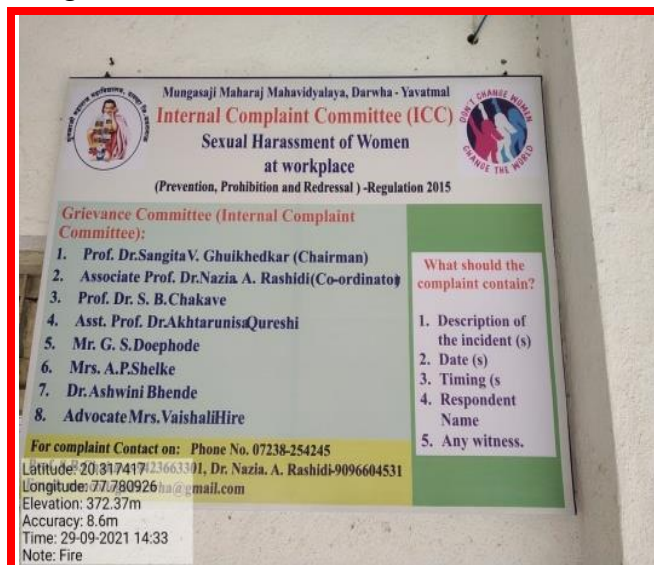
