
How do you rate the availability of text and reference books in the market?


How do you rate the quality and relevance of the course included in to the curriculum ?


How do you rate the treatment of the students by the faculty irrespective of the background of the students in teaching and evaluation ?


How do you rate the ambience (atmosphere) of the college for effective delivery of the academic process ?


How do you rate the quality of the teaching in the institution ?


How do you rate the outcomes of your wards has achieved from the course ?


