1. INTRODUCTION

The institution established under Vidya Prasarak Mandal Darwha in 1971 with Arts and Commerce faculty. Later on Science Faculty and H.S.C.Vc. have been started in 1983 and 1992 respectively. Besides these faculties, our institution has Arts and Commerce Faculty at Junior college level established in 1975 and a Faculty of Science (non-grant) at the same level has been opened in 2008. It comes under UGC Act of 1956, **2(F) and 12(B) since 1987** and continuation from 2012.

The institution is enriched with highly qualified, well-experienced and dedicated teaching and non-teaching staff. The institution runs **03** UG, **03** PG and 04 Ph.D. Programmes. There are **24** full-time faculties, out of which **07** Professors, **4** Associate Professors and 13 are Assistant Professors. Total **19** faculties are Ph.D. holders while **05** are pursuing Ph.D. Two faculty members are on BOS of S.G.B Amravati University and 01 member is on autonomous institution and 01 faculty has been working on Board of Physical Education and Sports. One of the staff members has worked on a committee to establish new Pali and Buddhism Department at University. The institution encompasses sprawling campus of **07** acres and Gymnasium Hall and many play grounds in a **15** acres land which is 3 km away from the campus. In last five years **10** students have won University Color Coat in various sports events. It is a great matter of pride that **11** students have also shown flying colors in the academic fields and have grab rank in the merit list of University. The institution has successfully organized **01** International, **05** National, **02** State, **14** University level conferences, e-conferences/workshop, e- workshop and 01 FDP on NAAC. More than 1500 students are enrolled every year.

The institution arranges various activities to imbibe and inculcate social, moral, patriotic, spiritual and national values among the students.



6. EDUCATION PROCESS

Our instituation is committed to quality education and training, propelled the growth of our students. We shape our students by honing their skills, instilling a sense of responsibility in nation building by cherishing humane values. In our efforts towards the above mentioned goal, we have introduced different courses to bridge the gap between the institution and the industry. We assess the students' strengths and weaknesses in academics and aptitude and address their needs through various Bridge Courses, Certificate Courses, Modules on Personality Development, Courses on Life Skills etc. Use of Information & Communication Technology(ICT) and other visual aids support, enhance, and optimise the delivery of information in education by integrating technology to the curriculum has a significant and positive impact on students' achievements. Our students are exposed to technology through education to have better 'knowledge', presentation skills, innovative capabilities, so that they are ready to take more efforts into learning as compared to their counterparts. Bridge Courses, Remedial & Tutorial classes, Assignments, Project work, Seminars, Guest lectures, Workshops, are integral part of teaching learning process to enhance the student learning abilities.

Tutorials and Remedial Classes

Some departments conduct Remedial classes for students who are below the expected level to build subject competency and to help them cope up with the advanced concepts. Tutorial classes are also engaged to the slow learners by paying individual attention, to motivate and help them academically.

Student Bridge/Induction Course

Such programmes strive to create a safe and caring environment committed to enhancing students overall growth through a variety of opportunities and experiences. It aims to provide information and resources that allows students to make informed and appropriate academic plans and healthy social choices.

Bridge Courses/ Remedial Classes

The instituation organized Bridge Course for entry level students. Remidial courses conducted for SC/ST/OBC students. Classes for slow learners and advanced learners have been organized.

Teaching- Learning Process

In order to give autonomy to learner, attention has been focused on acquiring life skills and practices that enable lifelong learning, develop independent problem solving abilities. The student's centricmethodologies adopted by our institution to provide enhanced learning abilities to the students.

Due to Covid-19 situation, lecture method is effectively followed in the online classes. The use of e-books, e-contents, e-reading material and video lecturers by experts shared with students through Whats App group, Google Classroom and e-mails etc. Home assignments and tutorials are given online. Institution has created its online repository. Some faculties uploaded their video lectures on college 'You Tube' channel and some prepared CD's on reading materials. Our library is consisted with good number of educational CDs and DVDs. In present scenario of Covid-19, social media tools are skillfully used by the college through WhatsApp, Zoom, Google Meet, Go to Meeting, Telegram, SWAYAM, NPTEL etc. The institution encouraged teachers to attend online training programmes, workshops, seminars and conferences related to the ICT use or innovation in teaching-learning.







Shodhganga: Shodhganga is an Open Access Repository of full-text theses submitted to universities in India. Membership is not required to browse, view, search and download theses available in Shodhganga. However, INFLIBNET signs MoUs with universities so as to facilitate submission of electronic version of theses into Shodhganga and synopses/approved research proposals into Shodhgangotri. The eligible universities that signs MoUs with INFLIBNET Centre on Shodhganga are provided access to anti-plagiarism software. Colleges are not eligible for this benefit. (Details are available at http://shodhganga.inflibnet.ac.in)

e-ShodhSindhu: Colleges that are covered under 12(B) & 2(f) Sections of the UGC Act and are under direct purview of UGC are entitled to get access to e-resources under NLIST programme except for Colleges imparting education in Agriculture, Engineering, Management, Medical, Pharmacy, Dentistry and Nursing. NLIST is college component of e-ShodhSindhu. NLIST subscribes to a sub-set of e-resources that are subscribed under e-ShodhSindhu. 10. Evaluation Process and Reforms

In the beginning of each semester, the students are introduced with the prescribed syllabus in detail by making them known with its scope. The syllabus pattern, weightage of marks and importance of some major topics from examination point of view have been discussed with them. The unit tests, home assignments, seminar, projects, interview and viva- voce are conducted as a part of internal evaluation. Such continuous evaluation allows the teachers to assess the students, track their progress and identify slow and advanced learners.

The students' laboratory performance is examined by conducting internal laboratory tests. Before the commencement of the university examination, preparatory examinations and question paper solving sessions are conducted to boost the students' confidence. Through text books, reference books, encyclopedia and N- list, Students get chance to improve themselves by means of such this continuous evaluation system before appearing for the university examinations.

In present scenario of Covid-19, the faculty try to reach at the doorstep of students by using e-tools also such as Google Classroom, WhatsApp, Google form, You tube, Zoom App, Google meet etc. The study material and questions related to the subject are posted on above platform. Students' also raised their queries and that are answered by the faculty.

Mechanism to deal with internal examination

To deal with internal examination grievances, there is a separate mechanism in our college. The internal examination grievances of the college students are either at the college or at the University level. The college level grievances are redressed by the Internal Examination Committee, the concerned heads of the departments. The university level grievances are redressed by examination coordinatorunder the guidance of the Principal.

If any student is unable to appear for the internal examination due to illness, participation in cocurricular, extra-curricular activities or genuine reason, the re-examination is conducted for such students. After the evaluation of the answer books, marks are displayed on the notice board. If there is any grievance regarding the internal examinations, it is redressed positively in time.

The follow up of University level grievances of internal examination is actively taken by examination coordinator of the college, so that such student may not suffer from their academic loss.

In this session 2020-2021 even and odd semesters examinations are conducted online due to covid-19 situation, therefore all the staffmembers have taken the keen efforts in minimizing the university level grievances of not only at internal but also university level examination. Due to online examination the grievances of the students are found very negligible.


